The NAPLAN assessments commenced for our Year 7 and Year 9 students last Tuesday 10th May and the catch-up testing will be completed this week. We use this literacy and numeracy data to plan our educational programs at the school level and to deliver differentiated instruction at the student level. The results will be available during Term 3.

# NSW Health guidelines for COVID close contacts

NSW Health has changed the guidelines around close contacts. Close contacts attending school will need to adhere to the following in addition to the NSW Health guidelines:

- You must notify the school if your child is a close contact and is going to attend school.
- If you are identified as a close contact, you need to conduct a daily RAT and return a negative result each morning before attending school for 5 school days.
- Close contacts attending school must wear a mask indoors (except when eating or exercising).
- No student identified as a close contact will be permitted to participate in overnight excursions, including school camps.
- Any visitor to our school site who is a close contact is required to advise the school that they are
  a close contact before they come on site. These visitors should conduct a daily RAT and return
  a negative result before attending. They must also always wear a mask indoors.

An additional distribution of Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) to all families has been completed earlier this term. Families can use these RATs during the 5-day testing period.
